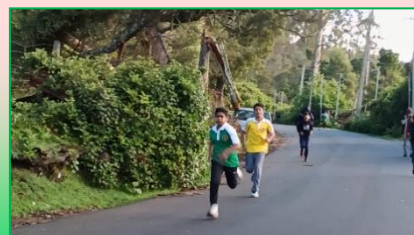


Bhavan's Annual Inter- Sangam Cross- Country Race 2025-26

Awareness. Dr. Mabel Raj highlighted the importance of understanding personal safety and emotional health. He guided the students on handling exam stress through



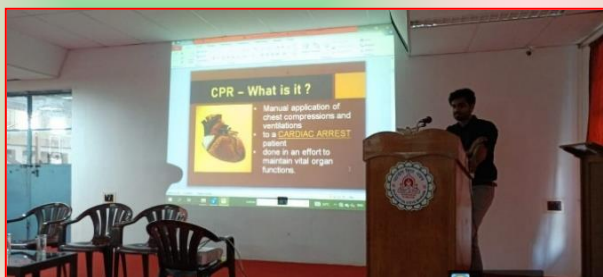
healthy routines, confidence-building, and positive thinking. The session also created awareness about the harmful effects of drug abuse and the importance of making safe and responsible life choices.

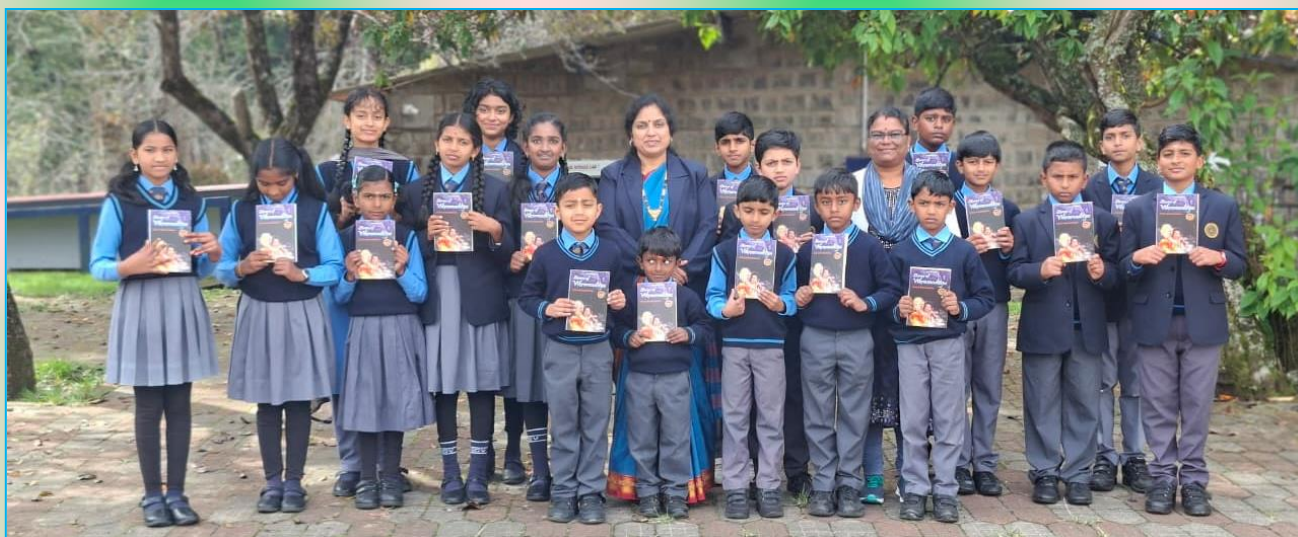

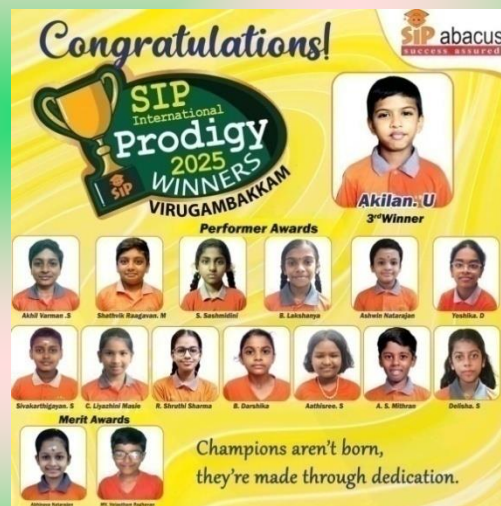
CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATIONS 2025

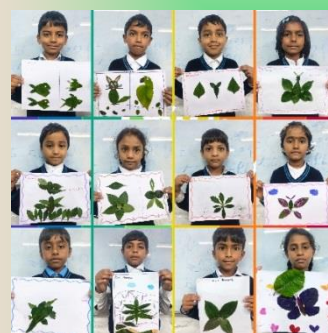
